2. PLEASE ENSURE YOUR BIKE IS MECHANICALLY ROADWORTHY FOR THE EXTENT OF THE EVENT. CYCLISTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN BIKE AND CLOTHING.
3. CYCLISTS ARE TO HAVE A LEVEL OF FITNESS AND HEALTH SUITABLE TO THE EVENT.
4. CARRY OUT A BUDDY CHECK WITH THE PERSON BESIDE YOU REGARDING BIKE, HELMET ETC.
5. PLEASE CYCLE 2 ABREAST MAX.
6. PLEASE OBEY THE RULES OF THE ROAD.
7. PLEASE OBEY INSTRUCTIONS OF STEWARDS/GARDA AND EVENT ORGANISERS
8. ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER AND ARE ASKED TO CHECK IN AFTER THE EVENT, TO ACCOUNT FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS.
9. PARTICIPANTS WILL BE SUPPLIED WITH AN INFORMATION MAP WITH EMERGENCY CONTACT NOS. DO NOT DISCARD.
10. PLEASE CARRY AN ADEQUATE SUPPLY OF WATER. WATER STATIONS ARE AT CAMP CROSS/ MARINA CENTER AND SLEAH HEAD.
11. TOILET FACILITIES ARE PROVIDED IN THE MARINA CENTER AND MARA BEO.
12. PLEASE IDENTIFY ROAD HAZARDS TO FELLOW CYCLISTS.
13. INCIDENTS ARE TO BE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY VIA PERSONNEL ON THE GROUND OR CONTACTING CLUB REPRESENTATIVES (NUMBERS ABOVE).
14. AN AMBULANCE, GARDA CAR AND 2 SUPPORT VEHICLES ARE BEING PROVIDED.
15. PLEASE BE SAFE AND ENJOY OUR EVENT.
