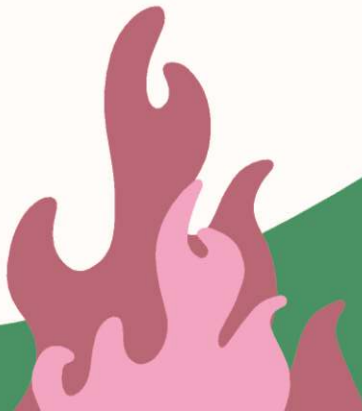

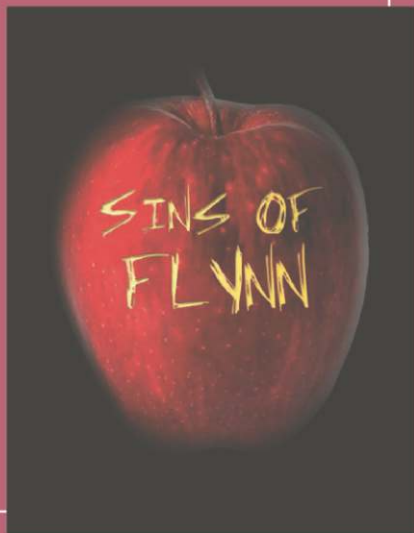

'Her voice is a superb mix of china cup fragility and steely strength.' It's 2022, more than a decade later, and this contradiction is still true of Pauline Scanlon's voice. As a founding member of FairPlé, the role of women in the arts is central to her creative path and something she is very vocal about and dedicated to. Her new album, 'The Unquiet',

The Unquiet is her third collaboration with John Reynolds as producer. Deliberately turning the narrative of old songs to face the modern era, she says 'This album is based on the life of my late mother, Eileen Scanlon and her contemporaries in Irish society. The songs have a resonance and a purpose in reflecting her lived experience and that of modern-era women in Ireland, through my perspective.'
